Use of Facility for Training

Club Requirements.

The following protocols have been developed and implemented for Clubs to return to training at Guildford Grammar School:

- Clubs MUST maintain an attendance register for all training sessions, including venue entry and exit times, and this must be emailed to Phil Marshall (phil.marshall@ggs.wa.edu.au) during the training session. (This information must also be available upon request by either Hockey WA or Health Authorities.)
- Clubs to provide proof that coaches have completed the Covid19 training course. (<https://covid-19training.gov.au/>)
- Clubs must set (clearly marked) areas for training, adhering to social distancing guidelines.
- Non-contact training.
- A maximum of one (1) small group of 20, this number also includes any coaches, per half field.
- Participants must remain in the same group and designated area for the duration of the session.
- Social distancing applies with 1.5m between all persons at all times.
- Players are requested to prepare and dress for the training session prior to arriving on the School grounds.
- Please only arrive at the campus 10 minutes prior to the commencement of the training session. Teams are to wait in the designated area towards the northern end of the turf facility.
- Players are only permitted to bring the equipment they require for their session e.g. stick, mouthguard, shin pads and water bottle.
- Enter and exit within ten (10) minutes of your training session starting/finishing.

- Goals are not be moved.
- Players and coaches must conclude training when instructed by the nominated venue manager or Ground Controller.
- Changerooms will not be open.
- Clubs must provide hand sanitiser which is to be applied by all present at approximately half way through the training session.
- The School will make available hand sanitiser at the entrance to the turf and all attending the facility must use this on arrival and departure.
- The water fountain will not be in use, those training are recommended to bring their own water bottle.
- The team dugouts will not be accessible to players.
- Players are not to access the Tech Bench dugout
- No warm-ups can be done on other areas of the School grounds. Clubs may wish to make alternative arrangements to warm up away from the School grounds.
- Clubs must provide their own First Aid kit and it is expected that Clubs will have an appropriately trained coach/player who is able to administer First Aid if required.
- No spectators or family members are permitted into the venue; spectators/family are to remain in or close by to their vehicles.
- It is expected that all those attending the Guildford Grammar School Hockey Turf have downloaded the COVIDsafe App.
