The Secretary shall exhibit the proposal on The Club notice board at least fourteen (14) days prior to such meeting.</p> <p>(c) Within one month after the making of any amendment or addition to the rules of The Club, passed by special resolution, the Management Committee shall submit the required documents to the Commissioner. No effect will be given to the amendments without the approval of the Commissioner.</p>
